UT Promise is a last-dollar, undergraduate scholarship that will guarantee free tuition and mandatory fees to qualifying Tennessee residents enrolling at UT campuses in Knoxville, Chattanooga, Martin and Memphis.

As a last-dollar scholarship, UT Promise will be applied after other financial aid is received. UT Promise is an expansion of scholarship offerings and does not replace existing scholarships. It is important to note that **UT Promise functions separately from TN Promise** and can only be used at universities falling under the University of Tennessee System. **UT Promise students are not eligible for TN Promise funds.**

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

Free tuition and mandatory fees for in-state students meeting all of the following criteria:

- Qualify for the Tennessee HOPE Scholarship.
- Be admitted to your UT institution of choice and enroll within 16 months of high school graduation.

TO MAINTAIN ELIGIBILITY A STUDENT MUST:

- Be a full-time, continuously enrolled student.
- Maintain the Tennessee HOPE scholarship.
- Complete FAFSA annually, including any verification requirements.
- Complete service and mentoring requirements each semester.
- * The accurate, verifiable total combined amount of parent and student adjusted gross income and untaxed income of less than \$50,000, AND, a total maximum asset amount of less than \$75,000, as defined by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
