

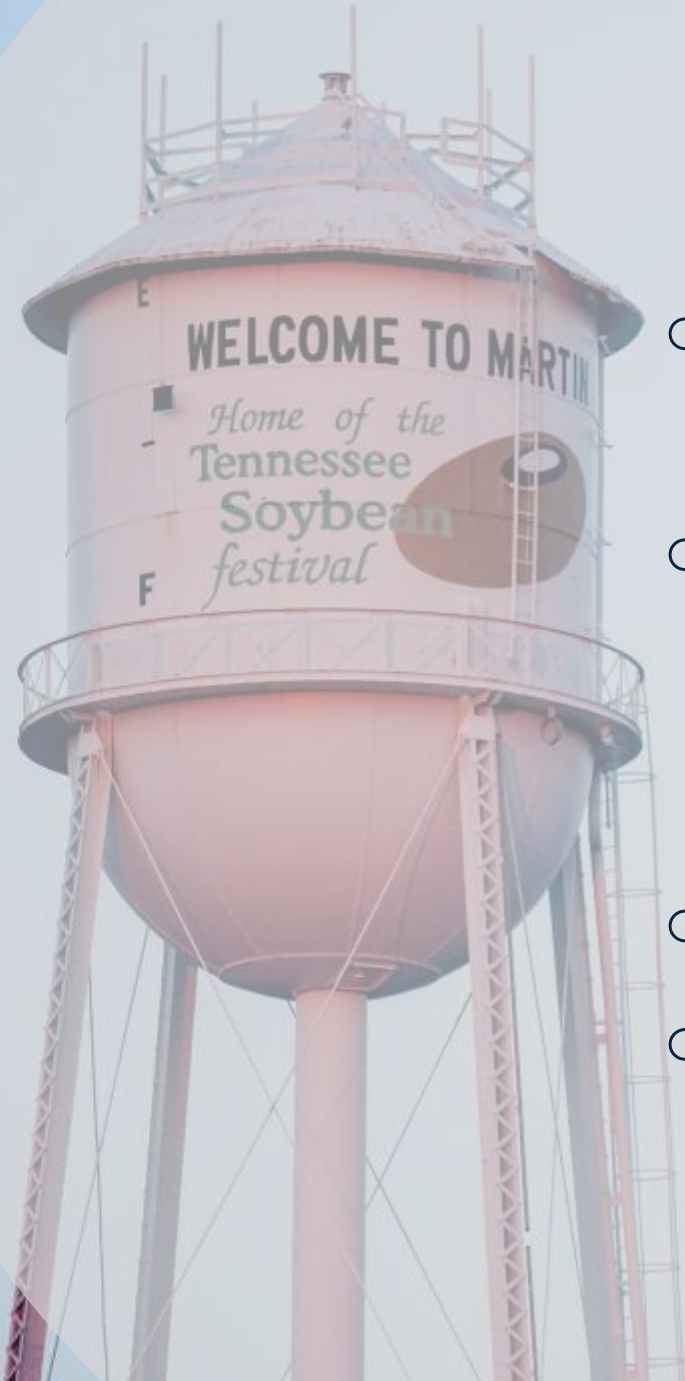

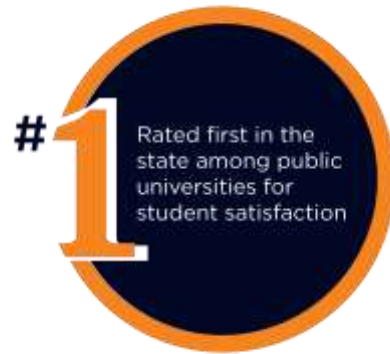

 - Education, Criminal Justice, Engineering, Music, Pre-Professional Health Sciences, and Agriculture





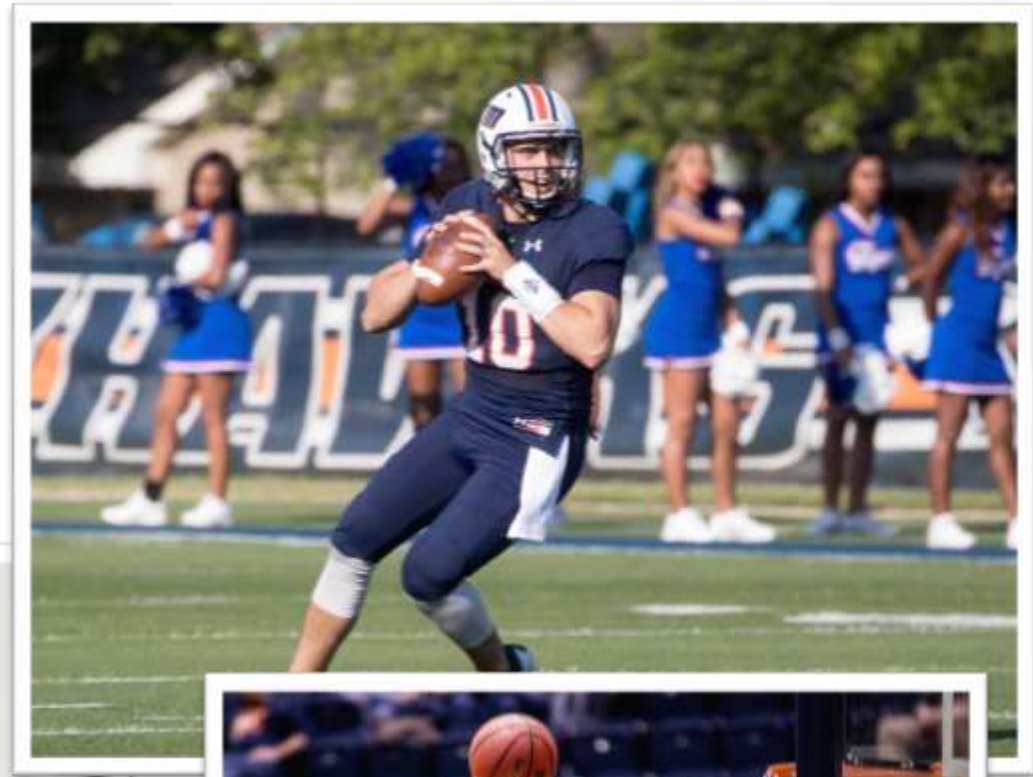
