GOAL: Make higher education more accessible and affordable for Tennessee students

MISSION: The mission of UT Promise is to **close the persistence gap** for UT students who are at risk of leaving the University by providing last-dollar scholarships and mentoring guidance.

DESIRED OUTCOMES:

- Be a tool in the state's Drive to 55
- Increase retention rates and degree completion
- Increase the number of UT students who graduate without debt

HOPE scholarship

The accurate, verifiable total combined amount of parent and student adjusted gross income and untaxed income of less than \$50,000, AND a total maximum asset amount of less than \$75,000, as defined on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Family household income under \$50,000, assets under \$75,000

Qualifying Criteria

Be admitted to and attend any University of Tennessee campus as an undergraduate

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UT Promise funds are applied after other federal, state, and institutional aid and/or scholarships (such as Pell Grants, HOPE Scholarship, etc.).

Last Dollar Scholarship

External funding and departmental scholarships will not reduce last dollar amount and can be used for other expenses.

Room and board, program of study fees, and book expenses, as well as other postsecondary expenses, are not included.

Student Guidelines

Maintaining Eligibility

Once you begin college, you still have to meet requirements to maintain your UT Promise eligibility! See the list below for a few to keep in mind:



Complete and Submit 8 Hours of Community Service Before Each Deadline

Eight community service hours must be submitted by the established deadline prior to each semester. Community service hours do not roll over from the previous semester.



Complete Mentoring Requirements Before Each Deadline

Three meetings with your mentor must be completed by the established deadline prior to each semester. Mandatory meeting requirements do not roll over from the previous semester.



File the FAFSA by the Established Deadline Each Year

Submit your FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov by the established deadline. The FAFSA opens Oct. 1 every year. If selected for financial aid verification, you must complete verification by your UT campus' priority date each year.



Enroll as a Full-Time Student Each Semester

You must maintain enrollment in at least 12 credit hours each semester. You must also maintain continuous enrollment. Remember, in order to maintain full-time enrollment, you must attend and participate in all courses. Failure to attend class could result in the loss of your UT Promise eligibility.

Maintain the Tennessee HOPE Scholarship

You must maintain the minimum GPA requirement and make satisfactory academic progress to keep the HOPE scholarship. If you lose HOPE, you will also lose UT Promise. You can regain the HOPE scholarship once. Visit the TN HOPE website for more information on HOPE requirements.

Prior to enrollment, incoming students will track their hours through tnAchieves. Once they arrive at UT, they will track through their campus



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


Volunteer Mentors Prior to enrollment, students will be paired with a tnAchieves mentor.

Upon arrival at UT:

- UT Faculty and Staff at the student's institution for freshmen/sophomores
- Alumni and Friends of UT for juniors/seniors





Mentors will be paired with 2-5 students and are asked to invest a total of one hour per month.

Volunteer Mentors

Students will be paired with the same mentor for 2 years.



UT Promise is a last-dollar, undergraduate scholarship that will guarantee free tuition and mandatory fees to qualifying Tennessee residents enrolling at UT campuses in Knoxville, Chattanooga, Martin and Memphis.*

As a last-dollar scholarship, UT Promise will be applied after other financial aid is received. UT Promise is an expansion of scholarship offerings and does not replace existing scholarships. It is important to note that UT Promise functions separately from TN Promise and can only be used at universities falling under the University of Tennessee system. Eligible applicants must meet the following requirements:

	NOVEMBER 1	Complete the TN Promise application:
1	DECEMBER 15	Apply for admission to your UT institution of choice.
	FEBRUARY 1	File the 2020-2021 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
1	ARCH/APRIL	Attend mentor meeting hosted by thAchieves.
	MAY 1	Submit all requested admissions documents to your UT institution of choice:
	JULY 1	Complete and submit 8 hours of community service.
	JULY 1	Complete financial aid verification, if selected.
	JULY 1	Ensure UT institution of choice is listed on your TSAC Portal and FAFSA.
	FALL 2020	Enroll as a full-time student at your UT institution of choice.
	FALL 2020	Paired with UT Promise Mentor.

Additional requirements:

Free tuition and mandatory fees for in-state students meeting all of the following criteria:

- A family household income under \$50,000.**
- Qualify for the Tennessee HOPE Scholarship.
- ... Be admitted to your UT institution of choice and enroll within 16 months of high school graduation.


To maintain eligibility a student must:

- Be a full-time, continuously enrolled student.
- Maintain the Tennessee HOPE scholarship.
- Complete FAFSA annually, including any verification requirements.
- Complete service and mentoring requirements each semester.

*UT Promise can only be used towards undergraduate programs at the Health Science Center in Memphis.

Frequently Asked Questions









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UT Promise scholarship funds can be applied to summer courses if a student is receiving HOPE scholarship funds. In order to receive HOPE funds, a student must be enrolled in at least 6 hours over the summer.









Will the UT Promise Scholarship cover fully distance education programs (aka online programs)?

Yes. If a student is enrolled in a UT degree program in which all courses are online, the UT Promise scholarship will cover tuition and mandatory fees.







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If a student meets the deadlines for both UT Pledge and UT Promise, is HOPE eligible, has a family income of \$40,000, which will they be awarded?

The student would be awarded the Pledge scholarship.









When will I hear if I received the scholarship?

Not until fall 2021. The sooner students complete their financial aid documents, the quicker we are able to award them.
