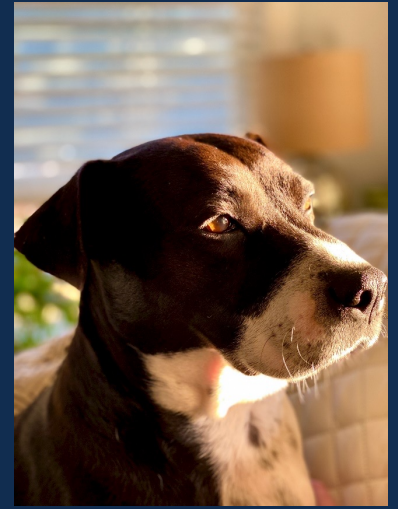

- Chemistry & Physics
  - Westbrook Scholarship
  - 4 years, 14k, stackable
  - Only Biophysics undergrad in the state of TN
- PT / OT
  - 100% first time pass rate on both National licensure test for both majors
  - First OT class 2017, 100% pass rate every year
  - 36 PT & 24 OT students accepted per year



# Program updates

- Nursing
  - Accept 40 students per semester (fall & spring)
  - Average 3.8 GPA
  - 98% retention rate
  - NCLEX pass rate in 2020 was 98%
  - 75% receive job offers before graduation
  - 100% employment
- Business
  - Completed renovation of Fletcher hall during 2020
  - Career Services center
    - 500 paid internship opportunities
  - Rollins Scholars
    - 4 year residential cohort scholarship program
    - 4k per year scholarship

# Admissions Changes


- Requirements
  - 2.85 GPA with an 18 ACT (960 SAT) or 2.5 GPA with a 21 ACT (1060 SAT)
- We take the highest GPA
- Continue to take superscores for admission & scholarships
- Fee waivers are still available
- ACT/SAT scores can be submitted a variety of ways



# Admissions Changes

## Test Optional Admission

- Selected during the admissions application
- ACT still required for scholarship eligibility
- If a student takes the ACT later, we will not hold that score against them.
- 3.0+ GPA
- Must submit a recommendation
- Recommendation comes via email to the person designated by the student in the application

### Standardized Test Optional Admission

In response to the Covid-19 pandemic, UTC is offering a test-optional admission criteria for fall 2021. Prospective students will have two options for receiving an admissions decision.

1. Students with current ACT/SAT scores or those planning to take the exam in the future can select the traditional admissions process based on the following requirements (2.85 GPA & 18 ACT/960 SAT or 2.5 GPA & 21 ACT/1060 SAT). Students with the appropriate test scores and grade point average will be automatically admitted.
2. Students with a minimum 3.00 grade point average that do not currently have an ACT/SAT score can choose the test-optional admissions process. To be considered for admission under this criteria, students must also submit one teacher recommendation.

Students whose grade point average is below a 3.0 with or without a current ACT/SAT will have the option to be admitted through a holistic appeal process.

## Institutional Scholarships

- Chancellor's Scholarship
  - 3.75 GPA & 29 ACT (1330 SAT)
  - \$9500
- Provost's Scholarship
  - 3.4 GPA & 25 ACT (1200 SAT)
  - \$7500
- Mocs Scholarship
  - 3.2 GPA & 22 ACT (1100 SAT)
  - \$6500





# Scholarship Changes

- Scholarship application available on Sept. 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Scholarship deadline is Dec. 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Students admitted by that date must complete the scholarship application by January 10<sup>th</sup>.
- UTC will now honor the December ACT for scholarship consideration



# Enrollment Timeline

- Application is available – Aug. 15
- Scholarship application available – Sept. 1
- Brock Scholars application opens – Sept. 1
- FAFSA opens – Oct. 1
- Admissions priority deadline – Dec. 1
- Housing application opens – Dec. 1
- Scholarship deadline – Jan. 10
- Orientation registration opens – Jan. 20
- Housing assignments begin - April

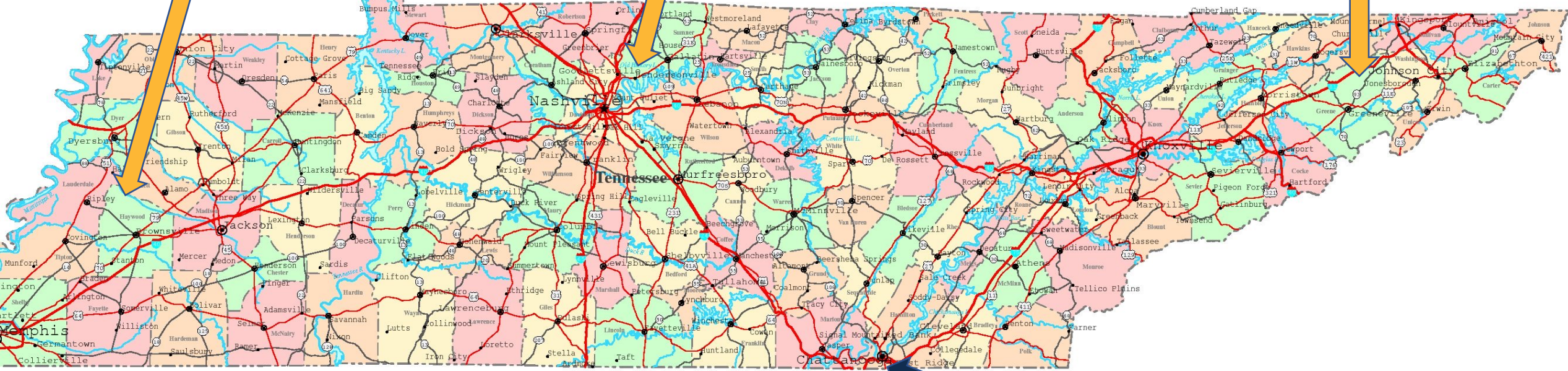
