It is our pleasure to offer you the position of Senior Vice Chancellor and Senior Vice President of the University of Tennessee Institute of Agriculture ("UTIA"), effective October 13, 2023. This appointment is subject to the terms and conditions outlined in this letter and subject to approval by the University of Tennessee's Board of Trustees at its meeting on October 13, 2023. Your compensation for this Senior Vice Chancellor and Senior Vice President role will be \$36,666.66 per month (\$440,000.00 annualized).

The position of Senior Vice Chancellor and Senior Vice President is without tenure, without a definite term, and serves at will and at the pleasure of the Chancellor of the University of Tennessee, Knoxville and the President of the University of Tennessee System. In the role of Senior Vice Chancellor and Senior Vice President, you will report directly to the Chancellor of the University of Tennessee, Knoxville and the President of the University of Tennessee System, and we will evaluate your performance annually. The dual reporting responsibilities of this role are outlined in the attached document.
