Program Design

Program Format:

Online: These classes are fully online with no campus requirement.

Timing for Courses:

Synchronous: Classes meet each week on specific days/times and will involve synchronous instruction throughout the entirety of the term. The days/times are listed in the class schedule.

Note: Asynchronous courses will also supplement the program.
